### Bylaws

1. The club is open to all potential members from law enforcement which includes police and prison officers 33.5% of members, all armed forces

services NHS and fire service 33.5% and 33% others all potential member will under go prospect period of 3 months by which they there membership will be put to the vote by current members whether or not they will be accepted.

Membership is open to all genders.

2. Any potential member must have a full motorcycle licence and own the minimum of a 250cc machine not scooter.
3. Whilst prospecting a cut will be provided with top and bottom rockers on with a prospect identification patch upon completing the prospect period full colours will be presented to be sewn onto the members own cut.
4. Whilst wearing colours the club is being represented therefore no disrepute must be brought to the club we are a LEMC therefore upholding the law whilst riding and social interaction whilst in colours. Any disciplinary actions will be dealt by the club officers then put to a vote by members

5. There is a chain of command however the idea of the club is everyone is approachable consequential all decisions will be to a vote by members. But as a club we will hold an AGM every year to discuss the running of the club.
6. Two meets will be held every month locations for the first to be decided and in the most the last of the month will be held at Gnosall social club.
7. Subs are to be paid by the 10th of every month at a cost of £5 per member directly into the club account
